

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF PERSON(S) TO SERVE AS MEMBER(S) OF THE SIXTH UMALUSI COUNCIL FOR THE PERIOD 8 JUNE 2022 TO 7 JUNE 2026

The Minister of Basic Education, Mrs AM Motshekga, hereby in terms of Sections 6(4) and 6(5) of the *General and Further Education and Training Quality Assurance Act, 2001 (Act No. 58 of 2001)*, invite a person(s), role players or organisations that are actively involved in General and Further Education and Training to nominate a person(s) to be appointed to the Sixth Umalusi Council.

The Sixth Umalusi Council will be appointed for the period 8 June 2022 to 7 June 2026.

In terms of Section 6(3) (a) and (b) of the said Act, membership must:

- a) be broadly representative of the General and Further Education and Training sectors and related interests;
- b) have thorough knowledge and understanding of General and Further Education and Training;
- c) appreciate the role of the General and Further Education and Training system in reconstruction and development;
- d) have known and attested commitment to the interest of General and Further Education and Training;
- e) have knowledge and understanding of accreditation, assessment and certification of General and Further Education and Training programmes;
- f) have experience in statistics; and
- g) have experience in the financial field.

The following additional requirements will be to the advantage of the nominee:

- a) have significant and appropriate stature in education and training;
- b) sufficiently linked and informed about the issues in the following institutions:
 - (i) Schools
 - (ii) Adult Education Centres; and
 - (iii) Vocational Education Institutions; and
- c) have the expertise and deep insight into matters of a transforming qualification and curriculum framework, examinations, evaluation and accreditation.

Nominations should be accompanied by the *Curriculum Vitae* of the nominee and a letter of consent from the nominee accepting the nomination.

The post of member of the Council is not a full-time appointment.
