I am honoured to congratulate all the accredited institutions being awarded accreditation certificates today.

The GENFETQA Act No 58 of 2001, amended in 2008, gives Umalusi the mandate to accredit private education institutions offering qualifications on the General and Further Education and Training Qualifications Sub-framework.

I congratulate the institutions awarded accreditation between 1 January and 31 December 2022: 120 independent schools accredited to offer the National Curriculum Statement (NCS) leading to the National Senior Certificate (NSC), three private colleges accredited to offer the National Report 120/121 N1-N3 Engineering Studies programmes, and one private college accredited to offer the National Certificate Vocational (NC(V)) levels 2-4. Of special significance is the accreditation of a private assessment body to assess the NSC and the General Education and Training Certificate: Adult Basic Education and Training (GETC: ABET).

These institutions have joined the elite group of 835 independent schools, 104 private Further Education and Training colleges, 22 private Adult Education and Training colleges and two private assessment bodies that can proudly

display their Umalusi accreditation certificates.

This is a great achievement and a milestone for all the institutions receiving their certificates today, considering all the effort that goes into meeting the accreditation requirements of Umalusi in order to be accorded the accreditation status. All institutions receiving the certificates have gone through a demanding process of accreditation in order to reach this point of receiving the certificates. This demonstrates capacity of your institutions to provide quality education to our nation. Alex Jasin posits that "Success is both a goal and a journey. When we reach certain milestones, that is an element of success. But we don't stop there. We push higher and harder, striving for more and to be better."¹ Please continue to uphold the good standards and requirements for accreditation and continue to strive to improve the offering and service of your institutions.

The accreditation certificate is a symbol of quality assurance that inspires parents, learners, and society to have confidence in the quality of our education system and independent institutions. I believe that your achievement today will inspire other institutions that are still in the process of accreditation with Umalusi. You have worked hard to achieve this. Today it is your time to celebrate. Enjoy the event.

Professor Yunus Ballim

Professor Yunus Ballim is the former Deputy Vice-Chancellor of the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) and the founding Vice-Chancellor and Principal of Sol Plaatje University (SPU), which opened in 2014. Professor Ballim graduated from Wits with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering, a Master of Engineering and a PhD in cement-based materials. He was appointed as a member of the 5th Umalusi Council in June 2018 and returned as the Chairperson of the 6th Umalusi Council in June 2022.



Dr Mafu Rakometsi

Dr Rakometsi has a career spanning 40 years in education. He has served as a teacher, lecturer, Head of Department at a college of education, and subject adviser. He was Head of Examinations in the North West Province in 1996, Director of Curriculum and Examinations in the Free State Province and later become Chief Director for Curriculum and Examinations. In 2004 he rose to the position of Superintendent General (Director-General) for Education in the Free State. Dr Rakometsi has been Chief Executive Officer of Umalusi since 2009.

Dr Mary-Antoinette Dliwayo has thirty two years' experience of working in the education sector, where she worked as a teacher, head of department, subject advisor and chief education specialist and led the planning, development and implementation of curriculum and assessment processes for the Further Education and Training Phase.

She became involved in the moderation of schools based assessments and marking for the national senior certificate which landed her a position of senior education specialist for social sciences in one of the districts in Gauteng. Later she moved to the Gauteng Provincial Department of Education where she became the chief education specialist responsible for coordinating the moderation of school based assessments for the GET and FET phases including the GETC. She collaborated continuously with teacher moderators to improve and build their capacity to moderate school based assessments from 2012-2020.

In the past she was also responsible for the certification and resulting of the grade 12 learners at the provincial level and also at Umalusi, that is where her interest in quality assurance emerged.
